How to Don the Caresia Arm



Fold the upper portion of your Caresia over the lower portion. Slide the folded garment onto your hand, then your lower arm.



2 Gently unfold the garment onto your upper arm and adjust to ensure the outer seam follows the top of your arm. Starting at your palm, apply your shortstretch bandages.

Easy to Care For

Washing



- 1 Machine wash with mild detergent on permanent press.
- 2 Double rinse to remove soap residue.
- 3 Do not use fabric softener, bleach, or other additives.

Drying



- 1 Tumble dry on permanent press.
- 2 Drying time can be shortened by laying the garment on a towel and rolling it inside the towel to collect excess water.
